Bexley Care Response Plan

MUST: Malnutrition Universal Screening Tool

- Initial assessment and throughout healthcare journey if clinical concern
- Robust District Nurse daily handovers, supervisions and team meetings
- Oxleas Embedded Learning events: MUST, Waterlow/Pressure Ulcer
- Must on RiO July 2017
- Add to staff competencies on Health Roster
- All Adult Community Services now undertake MUST

Oxleas Mandatory training Safeguarding Adults and Children

- Includes self neglect
- Monitored and reviewed in supervisions and training during embedded learning events

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Bexley Care Integration

- Adult Social Care, Adult Community and Mental Health together
- **Local Care Networks:** No silo working, robust MDT working in conjunction with Primary Care, voluntary sector , Bexley Council, Oxleas services bespoke care to individual need.
- Case management, collective ownership, transparency and monitoring of actions
- No referral to Mental Health services undertaken
- Joint care planning discussions
- Oxleas: My Care Plan (Jan 2017) District Nurse and Physiotherapist
- Connect Care
- **Single Assessment:** MUST, depression score, carer and parental responsibilities
- PHQ9 across Bexley Care
